Description:

SHSUGOM provides a curriculum of instruction that encompasses for academic years (eight semesters) of study. Candidates for the degree of Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO) are expected to complete the course of study within that time. Extension may be granted by the Dean upon recommendation by the Student Promotions and Academic Progress Committee or to accommodate an approved personal leave of absence. Such extensions will not exceed six academic years (twelve semesters) unless otherwise required by statute.
