## 2. REGIONAMODELFORMEDICAEDUCATION

In its effort to improve the medical workforce in communities in SHSU's service area, clinical educationshalloccurthrough a model of regional sites. The regions and facilities available for rotations are included in the clerkship manual.

Students shall accomplish their core rotations and many of their elective rotations within one region. Additionally, the ISSU Department of Osteopathic Principles and Practice shall provide hands-on training in osteopathic manipulative medicine in the regions contating basis. SHSU-COM shallprovide faculty development to optimize the ability of community preceptors to provide equivalent experience across sites.

Each region will have an assigned clinical coordinator who will work within the region to assure student rotations are arranged attending physicians are available and provide backupplans for attending vacations illnesses and other unforesee able vents. The Lead Coordinator housed at the medical school shall provide continuity, guidance, and direct supervision of the regional coordinators. The Director of Clinical Education shall oversee the coordination and is responsible for day oday student clinical education activities across the clinical sites.

## 3. OSTEOPATHMOEDICAISTUDENSSUPERVISIONNDLEARNING

Osteopathic medical students require supervision by a physician properly credentialed to oversee any activities in which the student engages in the care of patients. The sties actian be under the supervision of appropriate SHSOM or community physician faculty. Students are not permitted to provide care to patients outside of their clerkships or other SHSOM sanctioned ducational portunities, asstated in the SHSECOM policy on student supervision. Evaluations will be provided to preceptors using an electronic medical education solution Grades for rotations shall be based largely on COMAT exam scores and SHSU produced evaluation tools, and preceptor evaluations shall be used to gauge professionalism, ethics, and participation in the rotation experient of all rotations.
