

Work with three or more authors (MLA 232-233)

If the source has three or more authors, the entry in the works-cited list begins with the first author's name followed by . If you refer to the coauthors in your prose rather than in a parenthetical citation, you may list all the names or provide the name of the first collaborator followed by "and others" or "and colleagues." In a parenthetical citation, list the last name of the first author and .

Citation in prose:

Raymond Nickerson and colleagues argue that the truth value of statements—their premises and conclusions—is one factor that affects how people are persuaded by arguments (135).

Parenthetical citation (last names only):

The authors argue that the truth value of statements—their premises and conclusions—is one factor that affects how people are persuaded by arguments (Nickerson et al. 135).
