

Dear faculty,

As in previous years, the tenure and promotion informational message will be sent out to all faculty in the coming days. This will be an email from Jamilyn White detailing the tenure and promotion review process and timeline in accordance with <u>Academic Policy Statement 900417</u>.

As discussed in an <u>email from me on Oct. 21</u>, as well as in the recent college visits, this year's tenure and promotion review packets will be uploaded into Watermark Workflow, not Talent Management.

Tenure and Promotion Candidates

For those who are tenure and promotion candidates this year, you will receive a Watermark-generated email with an "Office of the Provost" sender name **no later than Tuesday, Nov. 22**. This email will notify you that Watermark is now available for document uploads related to your review. Once you receive the Watermark email, you can also <u>access Watermark Workflow directly</u>. The deadline to submit is Jan. 8, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. CT.
